

SCHOOL-WIDE POSITIVE BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION SUPPORT POLICY

At International Academy of Columbus, we know that student behavior has a direct link to the learning of the school as a whole. For this reason, we have implemented a school-wide positive behavior intervention support policy. Every teacher in the school follows the same policy. We focus on three R's: Students are respectful, reliable, and responsible

We use an internet-based behavior tracking program called Live School. This program has an app that allows teachers to give points to students, rewarding them for positive behaviors. Teachers have the ability to make comments on the specifics when they award points. We focus on positive behaviors, but teachers do have the ability to remove points when needed. Students accumulate points and then spend them on rewards such as snacks, a pizza party, or even gift cards. Parents and students are held accountable, because they have their own app that lets them viewpoints given in real time.
